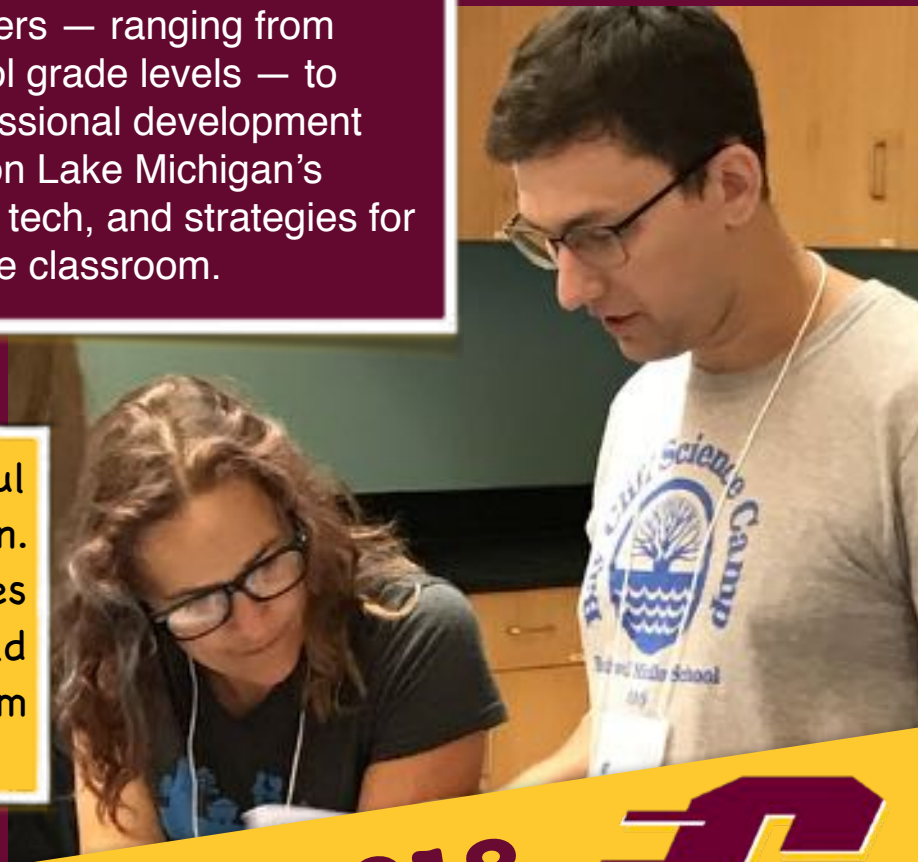


# Central Michigan University 2018 Beaver Island Institute
