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2023 Beaver Island Institute

We invite K-12 teachers to a unique, one-week professional development institute at CMU's Biological Station on Lake Michigan's Beaver Island.

From July 16 (Sunday) to July 21 (Friday), teachers who register for the 2023 Beaver Island Institute will live and learn at CMU's Biological Station and participate in inquiry-driven, placed-based disciplinary literacy learning, all while sharing teaching practices with a group of supportive colleagues.

How

Early Bird Registration through April 28, 2023: \$625

Regular Registration from April 29th — June 2nd: \$675

Registrations are transferrable, but not refundable.

Who

K-12 teachers who are interested in integrating content literacy strategies, authentic argument writing with evidence, informational text reading strategies, and writing opportunities with data analysis.

Included in the registration fee: lodging, meals, and a ferry ride from Charlevoix to the island and back.

Participants will be responsible for travel to and from Charlevoix, Michigan.
